

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL

(VARIOUS ROADS, BARTONSHAM, HEREFORD) (7.5 TONNES MAXIMUM GROSS WEIGHT) ORDER 2014

The County of Herefordshire District Council (known as "Herefordshire Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 1, 2 and 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby make the following Order:

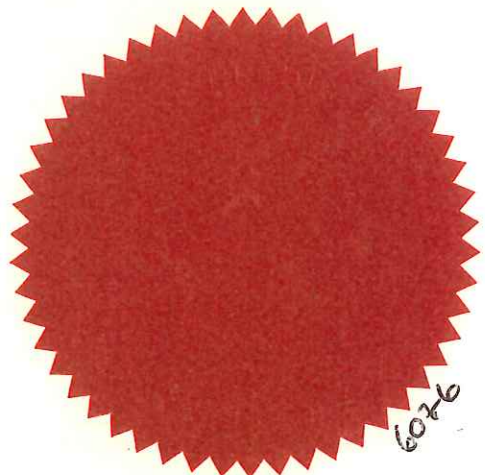
1. This Order shall come into operation on the 4th day of April 2014 and may be cited as the Herefordshire Council (Various Roads, Bartonsham, Hereford) (7.5 tonnes maximum gross weight) Order 2014.
2. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform or of a Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform (when authorised by statute), cause or permit any vehicle, the maximum gross weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes to proceed along the lengths of road as stated in the Schedule hereto and as shown for identification purposes only on the attached plan.
3. In this Order "maximum gross weight" shall have the same meaning as in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 as amended.
4. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause a vehicle exceeding 7.5 tonnes gross weight to proceed along the length of roads referred to in the Schedule hereto if the vehicle:-
 - (a) is being used for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise, furniture or effects to or from any land or premises situate on or adjacent to the said length of road to which there is no satisfactory alternative means of access;
 - (b) is being used in connection with any building or industrial operation or demolition in or adjacent to the length of road, the removal of any obstruction of traffic, or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said length of road or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to the length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Communications Act 2003 (as amended);
 - (c) is being used in an emergency for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;

- (d) is being used for the purposes of agriculture in connection with land adjacent to the said length of road for or in connection with the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon that land;
 - (e) is being used to proceed to or from any premises which are situated on or adjacent to the said length of road and at which the vehicle is to be, or has been garaged, serviced or repaired;
 - (f) is being used in connection with a circus, fair or similar event the holding of which is on, or in the vicinity of the said length of road and has had prior written authorisation by the Council;
 - (g) is being used on the said length of road for or in connection with the conveyance of goods for sale from that vehicle;
 - (h) is being used to gain access to any land or premises situated on or adjacent to the said length of road to which there is not a satisfactory alternative means of vehicular access;
 - (i) is a mechanical road cleansing vehicle;
 - (j) cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, other than the said length of road specified in this Order, when being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
5. The Council are satisfied that, for preserving or improving the amenities of the lengths of roads referred to in Article 2 of this Order, by restricting the use on the said lengths of roads of heavy commercial vehicles, it is requisite that Section 3(1) of the Act should not apply in relation to this Order.
6. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order any provisions contained in any previous weight restriction traffic regulation orders in relation to the lengths of road subject to this Order which are in operation prior to the date mentioned in Article 1 of this Order will be revoked in their entirety from the date mentioned in the said Article 1.
7. References to any statutory provision herein shall include reference to any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof

U80029 Vicarage Road From its junction with the U80024 Green Street in a westerly direction for its entire adopted length.

U80025 St Owens Gate Between its junction with the U80024 Green Street and its junction with the A438 St Owens Street.

U80026 Grove Road Between its junction with the U80024 Green Street Street and its junction with the A438 St Owens Street.

U80027 Grenfell Road Between its junction with the U80024 Green Street Street and its junction with the A438 St Owens Street.

U80028 St James Road Between its junction with the U80024 Green Street Street and its junction with the A438 St Owens Street.

U80030 Harold Street Between its junction with the U80024 Green Street and its junction with the U80033 Park Street.

U80032 Bartonsham Road Between its junction with the U80030 Harold Street and its junction with the B4224 Eign Road.

U80031 Hampton Street Between its junction with the U80030 Harold Street and its junction with the U80033 Park Street.

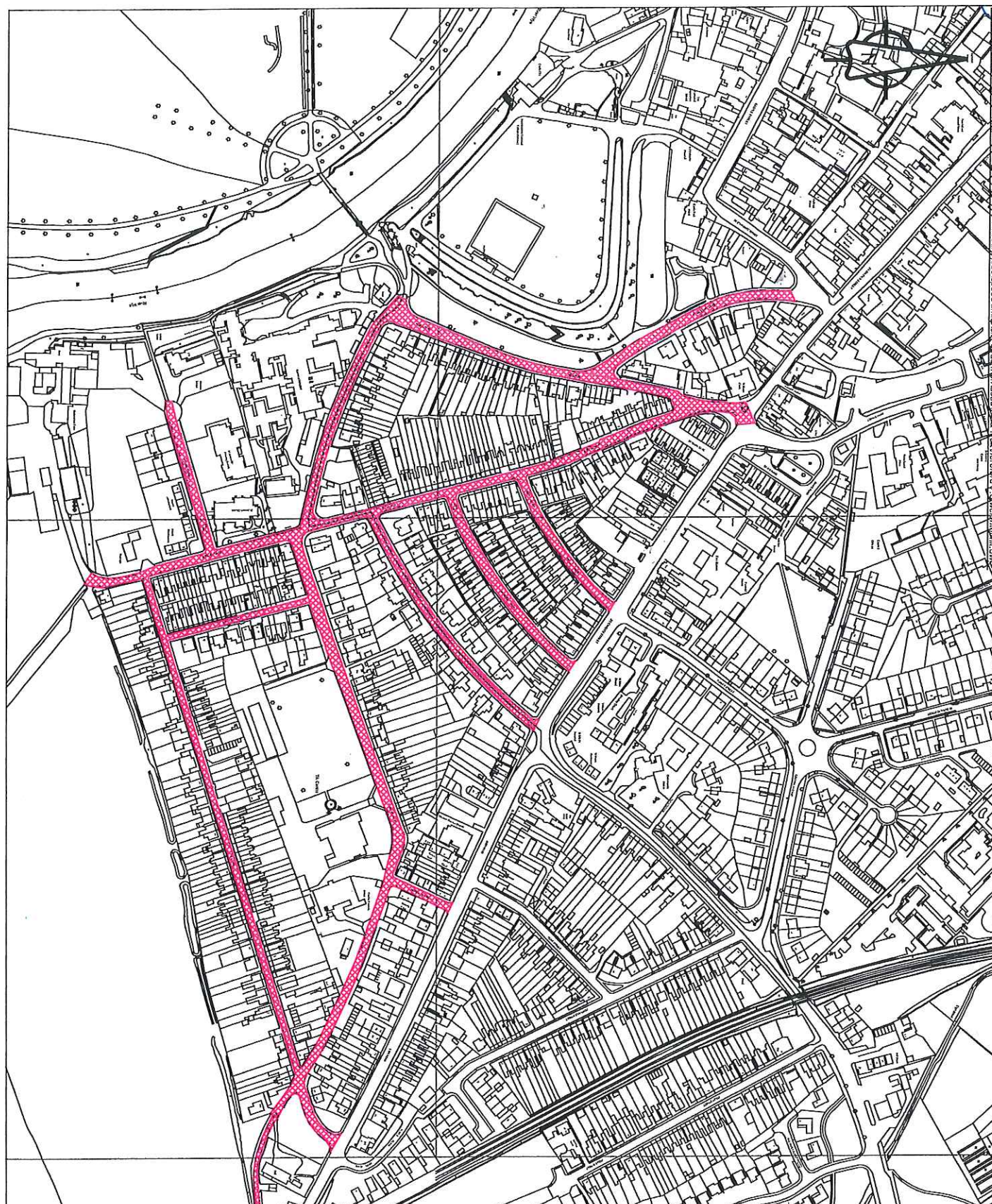
U80033 Park Street Between its junction with the U80024 Green Street and its junction with the B4224 Eign Road.

U80034 Crozen Lane Between its junction with the U80033 Park Street and its junction with the U80035 Outfall Works Road.

U80035 Outfall Works Road From its junction with the B4224 Eign Road for its entire adopted length.

U80022 Cantilupe Street Between its junction with the U80023 Mill Street and a point 30 metres south of its junction with the U80010 St Owens Street.
