Notice is hereby given that Herefordshire Council has made the above-named Order, the effect of which will introduce the following:

40 mph speed limit, B4214: From a point 88 metres in a northerly direction from its junction with the A438 for a distance of 875 metres in a northerly direction.

The Order came into operation on the 13th June 2014.

The County of Herefordshire District Council ("known as Herefordshire Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Herefordshire Council (B4214, Orchard Business Park, Ledbury) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2014 and shall come into operation on the 13th day of June 2014
2. No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour along the following road:

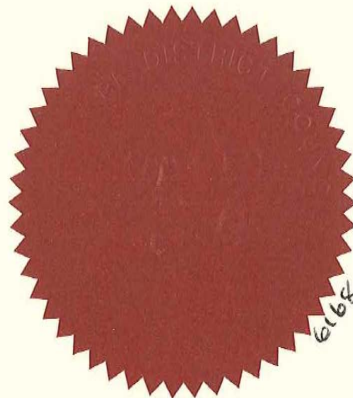
From a point 88 metres in a northerly direction from its junction with the A438 for a distance of 875 metres in a northerly direction.

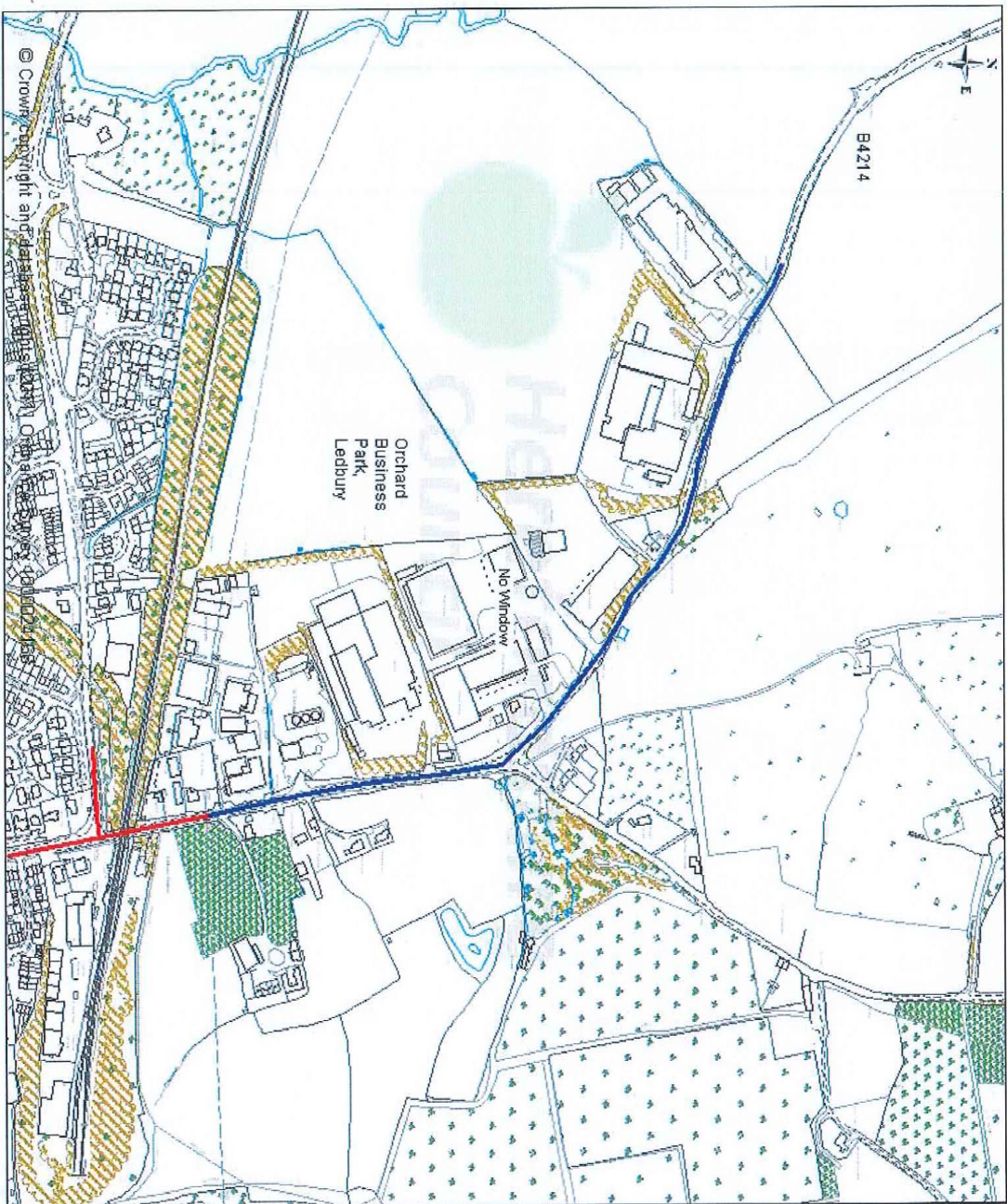

3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemption (Special Forces) (Variation Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
