### (A466, B4348, C1264 & U71620 Wormelov) (30 mph Speed Limit) Order 2017

Notice is hereby given that Herefordshire Council has made the above-named Order, the effect of which introduces the following:

**30 mph Speed Limit: A466:** From a point 30 metres north of its junction with the C1264 Tump Lane to a point 50 metres south of its southern junction with the B4348. **B4348:** (a) From its northern junction with the A466 for a distance of 171.2 metres in a north westerly direction. (b) From its southern junction with the A466 for a distance of 75 metres in a south easterly direction. **C1264 Tump Lane:** For its full length from its junction with the A49 to its junction with the A466. **U71620 Tump Lane Side Road:** For its full length from its junction with the C1264 Tump Lane.

### (C1264 Tump Lane, Wormelov) (7.5 Tonnes Maximum Gross Weight) Order 2017

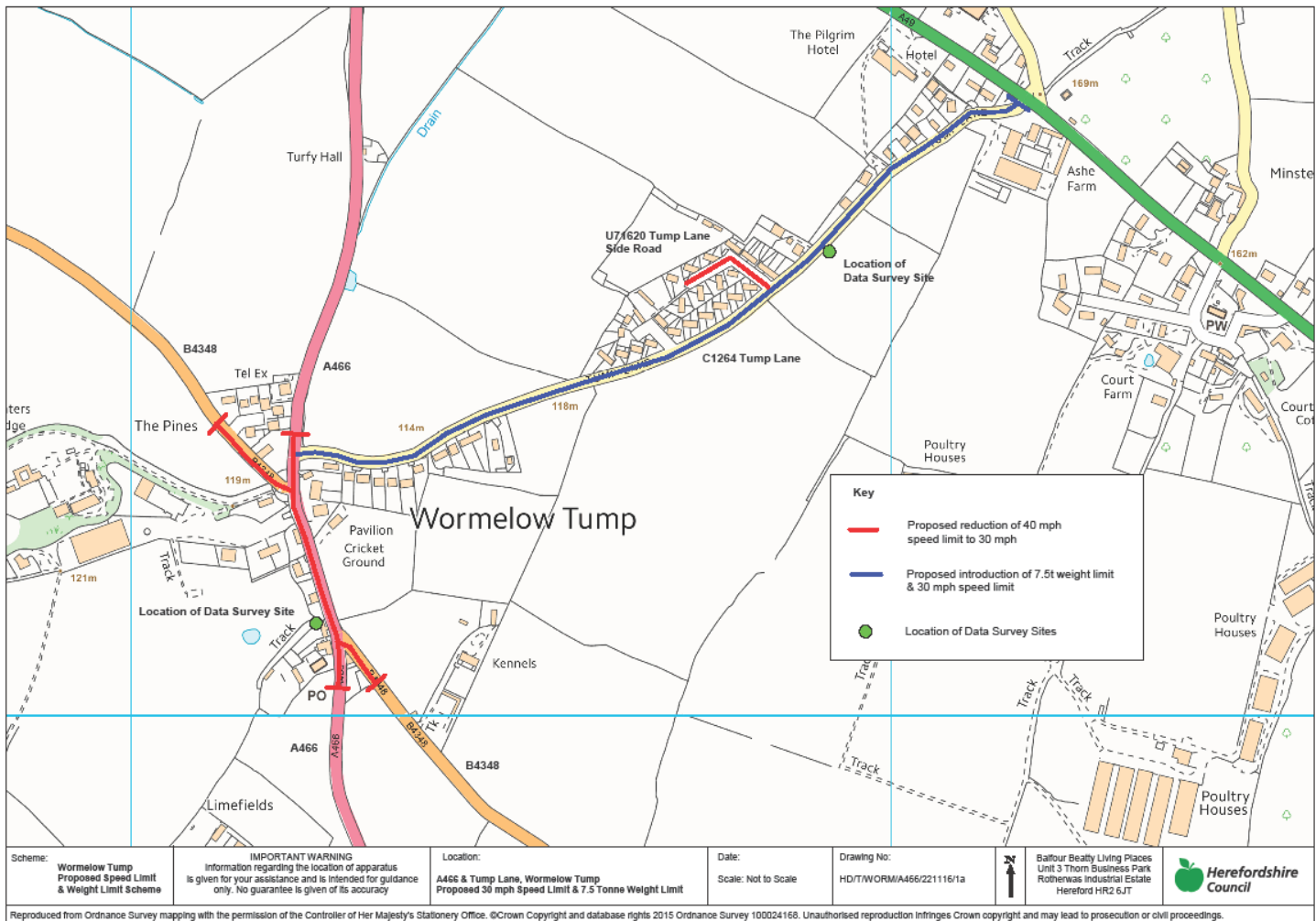
Notice is hereby given that Herefordshire Council has made the above-named Order, the effect of which introduces the following:

**Prohibition of vehicles exceeding 7.5 tonnes maximum gross weight: C1264 Tump Lane:** For its full length from its junction with the A49 to its junction with the A466.

**These Orders come into operation on the 13<sup>th</sup> October 2017.**

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with that person may do so by application to the High Court within six weeks from the date the order was made.

#### **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

The implementation of the prohibition of vehicles exceeding 7.5 tonnes maximum gross weight along the C1264 Tump Lane, Wormelow is required;

- for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising;
- for facilitating the passage on the road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians);
- for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs:

# ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

## HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL

### (C1264 TUMP LANE, WORMELOW) (7.5 TONNES MAXIMUM GROSS WEIGHT) ORDER 2017

The County of Herefordshire District Council (known as "Herefordshire Council") in exercise of their powers under sections 1, 2 and 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (referred to as "the Act"), the Road Traffic Act 1991 (as amended) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the.....<sup>13<sup>th</sup></sup>.....day of.....<sup>OCTOBER</sup>.....  
2017 and may be cited as the Herefordshire Council (C1264 Tump Lane,  
Wormelow) (7.5 Tonnes Maximum Gross Weight) Order 2017.

2. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform or of a Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform (when authorised by statute), cause or permit any Vehicle, the Maximum Gross Weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes to proceed along the C1264 Tump Lane, Wormelow for its full length from its junction with the A49 to its junction with the A466 and as shown for identification purposes only on the attached plan.

3. In this Order –

Any reference to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment. Where the context otherwise requires the following expressions have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them.

"Heavy Commercial Vehicle" has the meaning as in section 138 of the Act;

"Vehicle" means "Heavy Commercial Vehicle";

"Maximum Gross Weight" shall have the same meaning as in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016:

4. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause a Vehicle exceeding 7.5 tonnes Maximum Gross Weight to proceed along the length of roads referred to in that Article if the Vehicle:-

(a) is being used for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise, furniture or effects to or from any land or premises situate on or adjacent to the said length of road to which there is no satisfactory alternative means of access;

(b) is being used in connection with any building or industrial operation or demolition in or adjacent to the length of road, the removal of any obstruction of traffic, or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said length of road or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to the length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Communications Act 2003 (as amended);

- (c) is being used in an emergency for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
  - (d) is being used for the purposes of agriculture in connection with land adjacent to the said length of road for or in connection with the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon that land;
  - (e) is being used to proceed to or from any premises which are situated on or adjacent to the said length of road and at which the vehicle is to be, or has been garaged, serviced or repaired;
  - (f) is being used in connection with a circus, fair or similar event the holding of which is on, or in the vicinity of the said length of road and has had prior written authorisation by the Council;
  - (g) is being used on the said length of road for or in connection with the conveyance of goods for sale from that vehicle;
  - (h) is being used to gain access to any land or premises situated on or adjacent to the said length of road to which there is not a satisfactory alternative means of vehicular access;
  - (i) is a mechanical road cleansing vehicle;
  - (j) cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, other than the said length of road specified in this Order, when being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties:
5. The Council are satisfied that, for preserving or improving the amenities of the lengths of roads referred to in Article 1 of this Order, by restricting the use on the said lengths of roads of Heavy Commercial Vehicles, it is requisite that Section 3(1) of the Act should not apply in relation to this Order.
6. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order any provisions contained in any previous weight restriction traffic regulation orders in relation to the said lengths of road subject to this Order which are in operation prior to the date mentioned in Article 1 of this Order will be revoked in their entirety from the date mentioned in the said Article 1.
7. References to any statutory provision herein shall include reference to any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof.
