Recycling is collected one week and rubbish the next. Please note: Extra bags will not be collected www.herefordshire.gov.uk/bin-collection

- X** Plastic films and carrier bags
- X** Polystyrene
- X** Textiles
- X** Tissue and kitchen roll
- X** Biscuit wrappers and crisp bags
- X** Black plastic

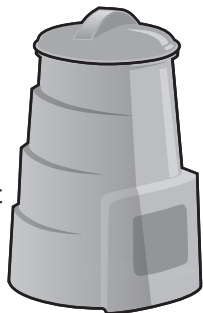
