Dear Susannah, thank you for consulting Historic England on these additional sites.

Although there does not seem to be a heritage assessment accompanying the consultation, having undertaken a desk based assessment it appears, in my opinion, there would be a negligible impact from a heritage perspective.

Madley - Stoney Street is of course a 'Roman Road' and the proposed site is immediately adjacent. However as the land has already been disturbed there is unlikely to be any surviving archaeological interest. Nevertheless you may wish to liaise with your heritage colleague(s) to consider their opinion from the local perspective.

Bosbury - With regard to this site, it does not appear that the significance of the Grade II listed buildings within the vicinity will be effected. Again we assume your heritage colleagues have been approached for their local opinion?
