I personally have been abused by Travellers when they took over the car park in Hereford where I had a parking disc, on exiting the car park, I stopped to ask the council worker where I should park and they drove at me, whilst swearing. I have children who are at an age where they can start to go out by themselves and do not want them to encounter any intimidation or violence. Whilst I fully appreciate not all Travellers would cause trouble I can only go from my own experience. What extra security measures would be put in place by the council? Stoney Street already has its fair share community events, all through summer the car boot takes place , and very often during this period we get fly tipping at the end of our drive as a direct result. We have Brightwells Auction which is a complete eyesore and creates lots of extra traffic when an auction if golf ahead. Until recently there was the packing factory and we are constantly fighting against business's keen to use the additional land on Stoney Street for industrial type sites,that would again severely impact on traffic and pollution. We are a small rural village, with narrow roads and no street lights and it's simply unacceptable to keep throwing things at Stoney Street that the local residents are havin to keep fighting against. Some of the initiatives being levelled at the residents could have a serious impact on the value and indeed the saleability of our homes which is completely unacceptable. I object to this latest idea in the most strongest of terms.
