

**(Hampton Dene Road, Hereford) (Parking Restrictions) Order 2015**

Notice is hereby given that Herefordshire Council has made the above-named Order, the effect of which introduces the following: **Prohibition of Waiting at any Time: Hampton Dene Road:** On the south east side from its junction with the Deaconsfield for a distance of 16 metres in a north westerly direction and 10 metres in an south easterly direction. **Deaconsfield:** On both sides from its junction with the Hampton Dene Road for a distance of 15 metres in a south easterly direction. **Prohibition of Waiting on Monday to Friday between the hours of 8am to 9am and 3pm to 4pm: Hampton Dene Road:** On the south side from a point 84 metres in a southerly direction from its junction with the Ledbury Road to a point 16 metres in a northerly direction from its junction with Deaconsfield.

**The Order comes into operation on the 14<sup>th</sup> January 2016.**

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with that person may do so by application to the High Court within six weeks from the date the order was made.

# ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

## THE COUNTY OF HEREFORDSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL

### (HAMPTON DENE ROAD, HEREFORD) (PARKING RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2015

The County of Herefordshire District Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 1 and 2 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (referred to as "the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 14<sup>th</sup> January 2016 and may be cited as The County of Herefordshire District Council (Hampton Dene Road, Hereford) (Parking Restrictions) Order 2015

2. (1) In this Order:-

"Civil Enforcement Officer" means a person appointed in accordance with the provisions of Section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004.

"Disabled Permit Holder" means a person who has been issued with a valid Disabled Person's Badge;

"Disabled Person's Badge" has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 2000;

"Disabled Person's Vehicle" means a vehicle displaying a valid Disabled Person Badge and Parking Disc; "Parking Disc" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regs 2000.

(2) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying:-

(a) a Disabled Person's Badge in the relevant position, when:-

- (i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the badge is exhibited thereon so that the front of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle; and
- (ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the front of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle.

(b) a Parking Disc in the relevant position, when:-

- (i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the disc is exhibited thereon so that the quarter-hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from outside the vehicle; and

- (ii) in the case of a vehicle not so fitted, the disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the quarter-hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from outside the vehicle.
- 3. Save as provided in Articles 4 and 5 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer or of a Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait during the times and for the purposes on the lengths of road as mentioned in the Schedule hereto as shown for identification purposes only on the attached plan.
- 4. Where referred to in this Order nothing shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides of those lengths of road referred to in the said Schedule and Articles of this Order so long as may be necessary where:-
  - (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - (b) goods to be loaded onto and/or unloaded from the vehicle;
  - (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the side of those lengths of road referred to, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said sides of those lengths of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
  - (d) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
  - (e) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets.
  - (f) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of removing furniture and effects from one office or dwellinghouse to another, or to such premises from a depository or from such premises to a depository, provided notice is given twenty-four hours in advance to the police, their consent is obtained and such reasonable conditions as they may impose are complied with;
  - (g) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes.
- 5. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a Disabled Person's Vehicle which displays in the relevant position a Disabled Person's Badge, and a Parking Disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in the said sides of those lengths of road referred to in Schedule 1 for a period not exceeding three hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same sides of length of road on the same day).

6. The restrictions, prohibitions and requirements imposed by this Order are in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction, prohibition or requirement imposed by any other enactment and any exception or exemption to the provisions of this Order is without prejudice to the provisions of any other enactment.
7. Any provisions of previous traffic regulation orders that are contrary to the provisions hereto as stated in the Schedule hereto as regards the lengths of road subject to this Order will be revoked on the coming into operation of this Order.
8. References to any statutory provision herein shall include reference to any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof.

### **Schedule**

#### **Prohibition of Waiting at any Time:**

U80137 Hampton Dene Road:

On the south east side from its junction with the U80168 Deaconsfield for a distance of 16 metres in a north westerly direction and 10 metres in an south easterly direction.

U80168 Deaconsfield:

On both sides from its junction with the U80137 Hampton Dene Road for a distance of 15 metres in a south easterly direction.




#### **Prohibition of Waiting on Monday to Friday between the hours of 8am to 9am and 3pm to 4pm:**

U80137 Hampton Dene Road:

On the south side from a point 84 metres in a southerly direction from its junction with the A438 Ledbury Road to a point 16 metres in a northerly direction from its junction with U80168 Deaconsfield.
