Do you want Herefordshire Council to use the neighbourhood plan for Linton to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area

Number cast for <b>Yes</b>	304	87.6%
Number cast for <b>No</b>	43	12.4%

The Number of Ballot Papers Rejected was as follows:

- (a) want of official mark
- (b) voting for more than one answer
- (c) writing or mark by which the voter could be identified
- (d) being unmarked or wholly void for uncertainty **1**

Total spoilt votes **1**

The total number of votes recorded represented **40.6%** of the registered electors.

**AND I HEREBY DECLARE** that the result of the referendum for Linton is as follows:

More than half of those voting have voted that they want Herefordshire Council to use the neighbourhood plan for Linton to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area.
