

Pleasure Boat Operator Licence Application with the BC Delivery Partnership Scheme

- Before applying for a Pleasure Boat Operator Licence with the British Canoeing (BC) Delivery Partnership Scheme, please familiarise yourself with the following licence conditions:
 1. **No Pleasure Boat Operator business can be used for carrying fare paying passengers until the proprietor has the following:-**
 - a) **Delivery Partnership Scheme Certificate, or notification from BC that the Operator is working towards the BC Delivery Partnership Scheme.**
 - b) **Valid full cover insurance including Public Liability Policy with Minimum cover of £1,000,000.**
 2. **Copies of a) and b) must be supplied to the Local Authority when requested.**

- Applications must be accompanied by the appropriate application fee per operator. Please call 01432 261761 (between the hours of 9:00am – 4:15pm, Monday to Friday) to make a card payment over the phone. Alternatively, cheques can be sent to the above address and made payable to Herefordshire Council.
- Before a Pleasure Boat Operators Licence can be issued a fully completed and signed application must be submitted to this Authority, together with the necessary fee, a copy of the valid Public Liability Insurance Certificate, and evidence from the BC that the applicant has, or is working towards, the BC Delivery Partnership Scheme.

If any part of the application is incomplete, the required documentation detailed in section 7 of the application is not submitted, or the application fee is not paid, the application will not be processed until such a time as all the information, documentation and/or fee is provided.

The data that is included in the public register is the Licence Holder, Licence Number, Licensable Animal Activity, Premises of Licensable Animal Activity, Species of Animals, Number of Animals, Star Rating and Licence Dates.

Where necessary we may have to share this personal data with partner organisations for the protection of public funds administered which may include the prevention or detection of fraud and auditing purposes.
