

Number cast for No	9	8.3%

The Number of Ballot Papers Rejected was as follows:	
(a) want of official mark	
(b) voting for more than one answer	
(c) writing or mark by which the voter could be identified	
(d) being unmarked or wholly void for uncertainty	1
Total spoilt votes	1

The total number of votes recorded represented **31.5%** of the registered electors.
