## Appendix B

### STATEMENT IN SUPPORT OF Note 7

This application is being made by the residents of, 'The Gresleys' HR9 5JN, a residential street in Ross-on-Wye. We have an excellent community spirit, a rarity in modern times. Residents frequently join together to take part in street parties, Christmas celebrations, local carnivals, weekends away, and other community events. We have our own Web site [WWW.GRESLEYS.CO.UK](http://WWW.GRESLEYS.CO.UK) where photos of some of these events can be found.

The green in question is a small parcel of land, but its use has been and still is, a very important asset to the locality, providing a viable space for many of our activities. Street parties, picnics, celebration of royal events and a safe play area where children and their parent can be seen on a regular or semi regular basis participating in informal sporting or play activities. These activities have been taking place as of right for at least 33 years for which photographic evidence is attached to this statement. Prior to these events taking place we have cut and raked the grass and have attempted to repair the grass verge which is damaged by passing vehicles

As a community we are also involved in charitable events and since 2002 have donated £ 4846 to worthy local charities. In 2004 we won the Ross In Bloom community award.

Granting Village Green Status to this small area of land which at the moment, having failed to find any evidence of ownership, seems to be waste ground can only with our help, improve its appearance, protect it from injury and damage and preserve its use for future residents and their children, who will be able to enjoy the green for exercise and recreation. The care and attention that we would then be able to give to the green would also improve the appearance of this residential area.



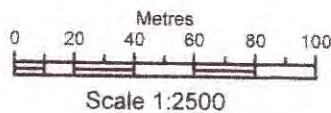
