Purpose: Horsehay Golf Club is an independent Club which includes a driving range, 6 hole Academy Course and an impressive Club House

Main lighting is by Metal Halide luminaries with compact fluorescents (CFLs) and LED's in some areas, with no EV charging points



Energy efficiency measure: LED lighting

LED Lighting – Light emitting diodes, also known as LED technologies, offer better working conditions through optimised luminaires, flexible lighting control and improved use of daylight.

EV charging point installed
Presence detection added in certain areas of the building

107 lights replaced with LED equivalents

Predicted energy saving: 34,052 kWh

Anticipated cost saving = £4,185/yr

40% Telford and Wrekin Council Capital funding
