## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

### **OF CONTINUATION**

**PUBLIC BYWAY WC62 (PART) WHITCHURCH,**  
**(TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2024**

NOTICE is hereby given that the County of Herefordshire District Council, known as Herefordshire Council, has made an Order under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), the effect of which is to temporarily close the following public right of way:

Public Byway WC62 from OS Grid Reference SO 5537 1685 to SO 5541 1677.

The Order for closure is required due to erosion.

There are exemptions in the Order to permit pedestrian access (and/or vehicular access at the discretion of the statutory undertaker) to any land or premises having a frontage to the above said highway affected where there is no other form of access; and to any access allowing the necessary works to be undertaken.

The alternative route is via Ashes Lane, B4164 and Meeks Well Lane.

The Order came into force on 2 February 2024 and was due to expire after a period of six months but as works have not yet been completed the Secretary of State has consented to extend the closure by an additional period of 12 months.

The continuation of the Order, by the above said direction, will mean that the Temporary Closure Order due to expire on 2 August 2024 will continue in force until 2 August 2025 or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner. Any further said extension will require the further consent of the Secretary of State.
