

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 119

**HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL
FOOTPATH MF29 (PART) MORDIFORD
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2024**

This Order is made by the County of Herefordshire District Council (known as "Herefordshire Council") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 because it appears to Herefordshire Council that in the interests of the owner, lessee and occupier of the land crossed by the footpath described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

Susan Warmington of Mordiford Primary School, the applicant, has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and to pay any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the footpath into a fit condition for use by the public.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Mordiford Primary School in the parish of Mordiford and shown by a bold continuous line on the plan contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. There shall be on the date of confirmation of this Order a public footpath over the land situated at Mordiford Primary School in the parish of Mordiford described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a bold broken line on the said plan.
3. Where immediately before the date on which the said footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of their undertakings, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.
4. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

Description of Site of Existing Path or Way

The existing route of footpath MF29 commences at County road C1292 at OS Grid Reference SO 5713 3746 (point A on the order plan) and proceeds in an east south-easterly direction for approximately 2 metres to pass through a pedestrian gate then a further 56 metres across a car park and along a narrow surfaced path to a pedestrian gate at OS Grid Reference SO 5718 3744 (point B on the order plan). It turns in a southerly direction for approximately 8 metres to OS Grid Reference SO 5718 3743 (point C on the order plan) then continues in a south-easterly direction through a building for approximately 51 metres to a stile and pedestrian gate, then a further approximately 3 metres to OS Grid Reference 5722 3739 (point D on the order plan).

The total length of the existing said footpath is approximately 120 metres.

PART 2

Description of Site of New Path or Way


The proposed new route of footpath MF29 being 2 metres in width commences at County road C1292 at OS Grid Reference SO 5714 3752 (point E on the order plan) and proceeds in a generally north-easterly direction for approximately 4 metres to pass through a pedestrian gate, then for a further approximately 32 metres across grass-crete to a pedestrian gate at OS Grid Reference SO 5717 3753 (point F on the order plan). It continues in a generally east south-easterly direction for approximately 80 metres to OS Grid Reference SO 5725 3752 (point G on the order plan), then turns in a generally south south-westerly direction for approximately 116 metres to OS Grid Reference SO 5722 3740 (point H on the order plan). The path then proceeds in an east south-easterly direction for approximately 6 metres to OS Grid Reference SO 5722 3740 (point I on the order plan) then in a south south-westerly direction for approximately 11 metres to pass through a pedestrian gate and a further approximately 2 metres to OS Grid Reference SO 5722 3739 (point D on the order plan).

The total length of the said proposed new footpath is approximately 251 metres.
