**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER**

**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 SECTION 118**

**HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL  
PUBLIC FOOTPATH KP18 (PART) KING'S PYON  
PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2023**

On 15<sup>th</sup> April, 2024 Herefordshire Council ("the Council") confirmed the above order made under Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the order, as confirmed, is to extinguish that part of Public Footpath KP18 in the Parish of King's Pyon which commences at OS Grid Reference SO 4272 5020 (point A on the order plan) and follows a generally north-westerly direction for approximately 247 metres to OS Grid Reference SO 4255 5037 (point B on the order plan). Total length of the path to be extinguished is approximately 247 metres.

Confirmation of this order shall be concurrent with the confirmation of the County of Herefordshire District Council Footpath KP18 (Part) King's Pyon Public Path Creation Order 2023.

A copy of the confirmed order and the order plan have been placed and may be seen free of charge at Blueschool House, Blueschool Street, Hereford, HR1 2AN during normal opening hours. This order comes into force at the end of 7 days of the said confirmation date of the order but if any person aggrieved by the order desires to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act, or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the order, he or she may, pursuant to paragraph 2 Schedule 2 to the Act, as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, make an application to the High Court for any of these purposes under Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 within six weeks from the date of this Notice.
