a) General – all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e) List here steps you will take to promote all four licensing objectives together.
As per the existing operating schedule including licence shop staff members shall be authorised in writing by the Personal Licence Holder to sell alcohol. A record shall be kept and made available on demand for inspection by an authorised person or the Police. The premises shall only be open and operate exclusively for the employees of S & A Produce resident at the S & A Produce Brierley Campsite
b) The prevention of crime and disorder
As per the existing operating schedule including Brook Farm shall employ a team of site officers who will patrol the campsite (including the shop area). An incident log must be kept at the premises and made available immediately on request to an authorised person or the Police which must record: all crimes reported/all ejections of patron/incidents of disorder/refusal of the sale of alcohol/any visit by a relevant authority or emergency service. The Premises Licence Holder/DPS shall successfully complete the BIIAB NCPLH level 2 (or equivalent). All staff engaged in the sale of alcohol to be trained in Responsible Alcohol Retailing to the minimum standard of BIIAB level 1 or any other training recognised and agreed with Trading Standards. All staff shall be retrained six monthly. Training records shall be kept on the premises which shall show the name of the training course attended/the date of the training/the name of the person undertaking the training and shall be produced to the Police or authorised person on demand
c) Public safety
As per existing operating schedule including The shop shall not be open to the general public
d) The prevention of public nuisance
As per existing operating schedule including Campsite officers must be present on site to prevent or any antisocial behaviour
e) The protection of children from harm
As per existing operating schedule including the shop will only be open to seasonal workers living on the campsite who are over the age of 18. The premises shall operate a Challenge 21 policy. Such policy shall be written down and kept at the premises. The policy shall be produced on demand to an authorised person or the Police. Prominent, clear and legible signage shall also be displayed at all entrances to the premises as well as at least one location behind any serving area advertising the scheme operated. The signage shall be in english and any other language which is relevant to the employees at the location. Prominent, clear and legible signage shall be displayed stating that "It is an offence to purchase or attempt to purchase alcohol if you are under the age of 18- Section 149 Licensing Act 2003" The signage shall be

displayed in english and any other language which is relevant to the employees at the location

NOTES ON REGULATED ENTERTAINMENT

In terms of specific regulated entertainments please note that:

- Plays: no licence is required for performances between 08:00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
- Films: no licence is required for 'not-for-profit' film exhibition held in community premises between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day provided that the audience does not exceed 500 and the organiser (a) gets consent to the screening from a person who is responsible for the premises; and (b) ensures that each such screening abides by age classification ratings.
- Indoor sporting events: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000.
- Boxing or Wrestling Entertainment: no licence is required for a contest, exhibition or display of Greco-Roman
 wrestling, or freestyle wrestling between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not
 exceed 1000. Combined fighting sports defined as a contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or
 wrestling with one or more martial arts are licensable as a boxing or wrestling entertainment rather than an
 indoor sporting event.
- Live music: no licence permission is required for:
 - o a performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
- Recorded Music: no licence permission is required for:
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school proprietor or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.

- Dance: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500. However, a performance which amounts to adult entertainment remains licensable.
- Cross activity exemptions: no licence is required between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, with no limit on audience size for:
 - any entertainment taking place on the premises of the local authority where the entertainment is provided 0 by or on behalf of the local authority;
 - any entertainment taking place on the hospital premises of the health care provider where the 0 entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the health care provider;
 - any entertainment taking place on the premises of the school where the entertainment is provided by or 0 on behalf of the school proprietor; and
 - any entertainment (excluding films and a boxing or wrestling entertainment) taking place at a travelling 0
