NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

**TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 SECTION 257
AND PARAGRAPH 7 OF SCHEDULE 14**

**HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL
FOOTPATH LU7 (PART) LUGWARDINE
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2024**

On 27th June, 2024 Herefordshire Council (“the Council”) confirmed the above order.

The effect of the order, as confirmed, is to divert that part of Public Footpath LU7 in the Parish of Lugwardine which commences at OS Grid Reference SO 5519 4124 (point A on the order plan) and proceeds in a northerly then generally east north-easterly direction for approximately 78 metres to OS Grid Reference SO 5522 4130 (point B on the order plan). The total length of the existing said footpath is approximately 78 metres.

An alternative footpath will be created for use as a replacement, being 2 metres in width, which commences at OS Grid Reference SO 5519 4124 (point A on the order plan) and proceeds in generally north north-easterly direction for approximately 72 metres to OS Grid Reference SO 5522 4130 (point B on the order plan). The total length of the said proposed new footpath is approximately 72 metres.

This order comes into force on the date of confirmation of this order, but if any person aggrieved by the order desires to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act, or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under Section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within six weeks from the date of this Notice as required by paragraph 7 of Schedule 14 to that Act.
