HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 119
HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL
FOOTPATH PR18A (PART) PETERCHURCH
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2022

This Order is made by the County of Herefordshire District Council (known as "Herefordshire Council") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 because it appears to Herefordshire Council that in the interests of the owner and occupier of the land crossed by the public footpath described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

Jason Richards of JR Planning and Development, the applicant, has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and to pay any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the footpath into a fit condition for use by the public.

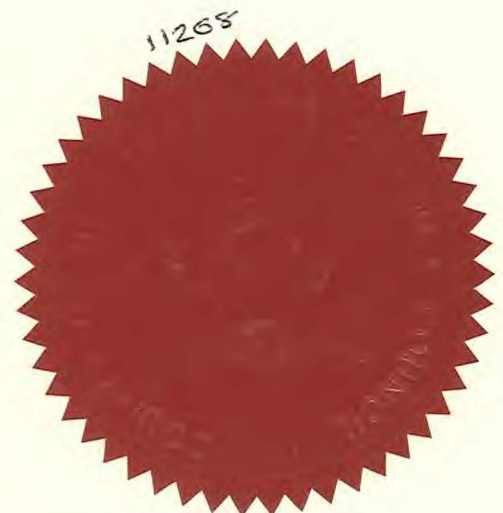
BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated opposite Hawthorn Rise, Peterchurch in the parish of Peterchurch and shown by a bold continuous line on the plan contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date that Herefordshire Council certifies that works have been carried out to bring the site of the new footpath described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order into a fit condition for use by the public.
2. There shall be on the date of confirmation of this Order a public footpath over the land situated opposite Hawthorn Rise, Peterchurch in the parish of Peterchurch described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a bold broken line on the said plan.
3. Where immediately before the date on which the said footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of their undertakings, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.
4. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

Description of Site of Existing Path or Way

The existing route of footpath PR18A commences at the County road B4348 at OS Grid Reference SO 3467 3836 (point A on the order plan) and proceeds in a south easterly direction for approximately 104 metres to OS Grid Reference SO 3474 3828 (point D on the order plan).

The total length of the existing said footpath is approximately 104 metres.

PART 2

Description of Site of New Path or Way

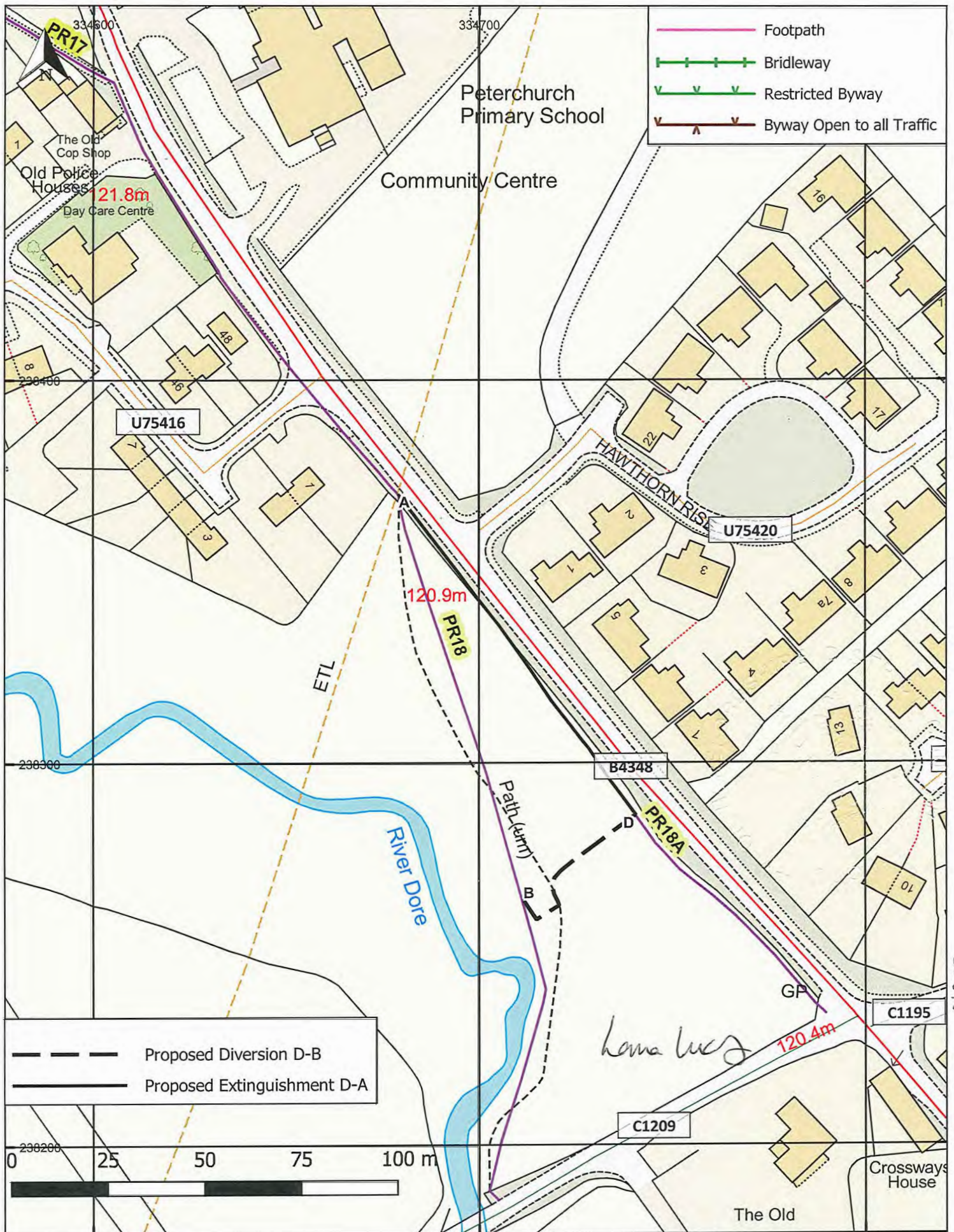
The proposed new route of footpath PR18A being 2 metres in width commences at OS Grid Reference SO 3474 3828 (point D on the order plan) and follows a generally south-westerly direction for approximately 29 metres, then a generally south south-easterly direction for approximately 5 metres, then a generally south-westerly direction for approximately 7 metres, then a generally north-westerly direction for approximately 6 metres to OS Grid Reference SO 3471 3826 (point B on the order plan).

The total length of the said proposed new footpath is approximately 47 metres.
