## PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER

#### **HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 119**

#### HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL FOOTPATH LY6 (PART) LLANCILLO PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2024

This Order is made by the County of Herefordshire District Council (known as "Herefordshire Council") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 because it appears to Herefordshire Council that in the interests of the owner, lessee and occupier of the land crossed by the footpath described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

Anthony Ling, the said owner, has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and to pay any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the footpath into a fit condition for use by the public.

#### BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. The public right of way over the land situated at Sunnybank Farm in the parish of Llancillo and shown by a bold continuous line on the plan contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date that Herefordshire Council certifies that works have been carried out to bring the site of the new footpath described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order into a fit condition for use by the public.
- 2. There shall be on the date of confirmation of this Order a public footpath over the land situated at Sunnybank Farm in the parish of Llancillo described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a bold broken line on the said plan.
- 3. Where immediately before the date on which the said footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of their undertakings, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.
- 4. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule to this Order.

# SCHEDULE

## PART 1

## Description of Site of Existing Path or Way

The existing route of footpath LY6 commences at OS Grid Reference SO 3759 2568 (point A on the order plan) and proceeds in an east north-easterly direction for approximately 43 metres to a field gate. It continues through a farm building and through the farmyard for approximately 127 metres to a field gate at OS Grid Reference SO 3773 2577 (point B on the order plan), then in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 119 metres to join footpath RW5 at OS Grid Reference SO 3780 2586 (point C on the order plan).

The total length of the existing said footpath is approximately 289 metres.

# PART 2

## Description of Site of New Path or Way

The proposed new route of footpath LY6 being 2 metres in width commences at OS Grid Reference SO 3759 2568 (point A on the order plan) and proceeds in a north north-easterly direction along the farm track for approximately 53 metres to a kissing gate at OS Grid Reference SO 3761 2573 (point D on the order plan). It continues in a generally westerly direction for approximately 12 metres, then in a generally northerly direction for approximately 200 metres to join footpath LY2 at OS Grid Reference SO 3757 2592 (point E on the order plan).

The total length of the said proposed new footpath is approximately 265 metres.
