

NOTICE OF MODIFICATION ORDER

SECTION 53 OF THE WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT FOR THE COUNTY OF HEREFORDSHIRE

HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (ADDITION OF BRIDLEWAY OL42 ORLETON) MODIFICATION ORDER 2025

The above Order made on 20th February, 2025, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by adding to them the bridleway as follows:

Addition of Bridleway A-B-C-D-E

Commences at its junction with County road U92623 at OS Grid Reference SO 4749 6885 (point A on the order plan) and proceeds in a generally south south-westerly direction for approximately 41 metres to OS Grid Reference SO 4747 6882 (point B on the order plan). It continues in a generally southerly direction for approximately 147 metres to OS Grid Reference SO 4746 6867 (point C on the order plan), then in a generally south south-westerly direction for approximately 117 metres to OS Grid Reference SO 4745 6856 (point D on the order plan) where it turns in a north north-westerly then northerly direction for approximately 247 metres to OS Grid Reference SO 4740 6880 (point E on the order plan). To be known as Bridleway OL42 Orleton.

Width: The route has a variable width between 2.3 metres and 3.6 metres

If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State, Department of Environment Food and Rural Affairs, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
