


DEPOSIT OF STATEMENT and PLAN



STATUTORY DECLARATION

SECTION 31 (6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980


I **Hugh Devlin** authorised Rural Surveyor for the National Trust for Places of Historic Interest or Natural Beauty (hereinafter referred to as 'The Trust'), West Midlands Regional Office, Attingham Park, Shrewsbury, Shropshire, DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:

1. The Trust is the owner of the land known as **Croft Castle Estate, Herefordshire** more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red.
2. On the **20 day of December 2004** I deposited with **Herefordshire Council**, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a plan delineating The Trusts property by red edging which stated that:-  
  
the ways coloured **blue** on the said plan and on the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as footpaths (FP)
3. No other ways over the land have been dedicated as highways.
4. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration since the statement dated **16 December 2004** referred to in 2. above and at the present time the Trust has no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over its property.

AND I MAKE this solemn declaration on the *1st* day of *March* *2005* conscientiously believing it to be true and by virtue of the Statutory Declarations Act 1835.



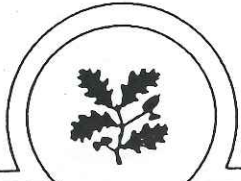

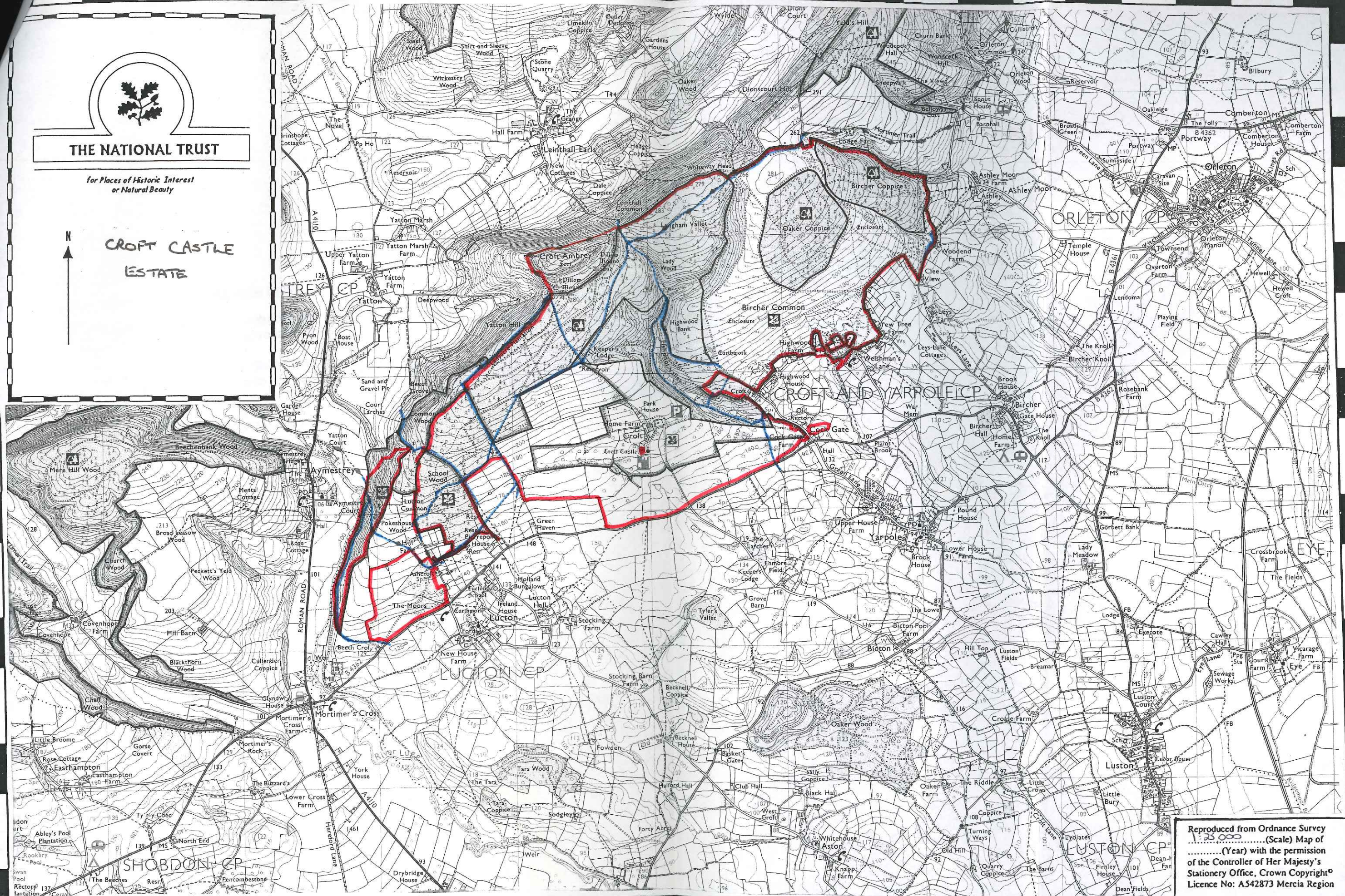
