The deposit comprises this statement and the accompanying plan.

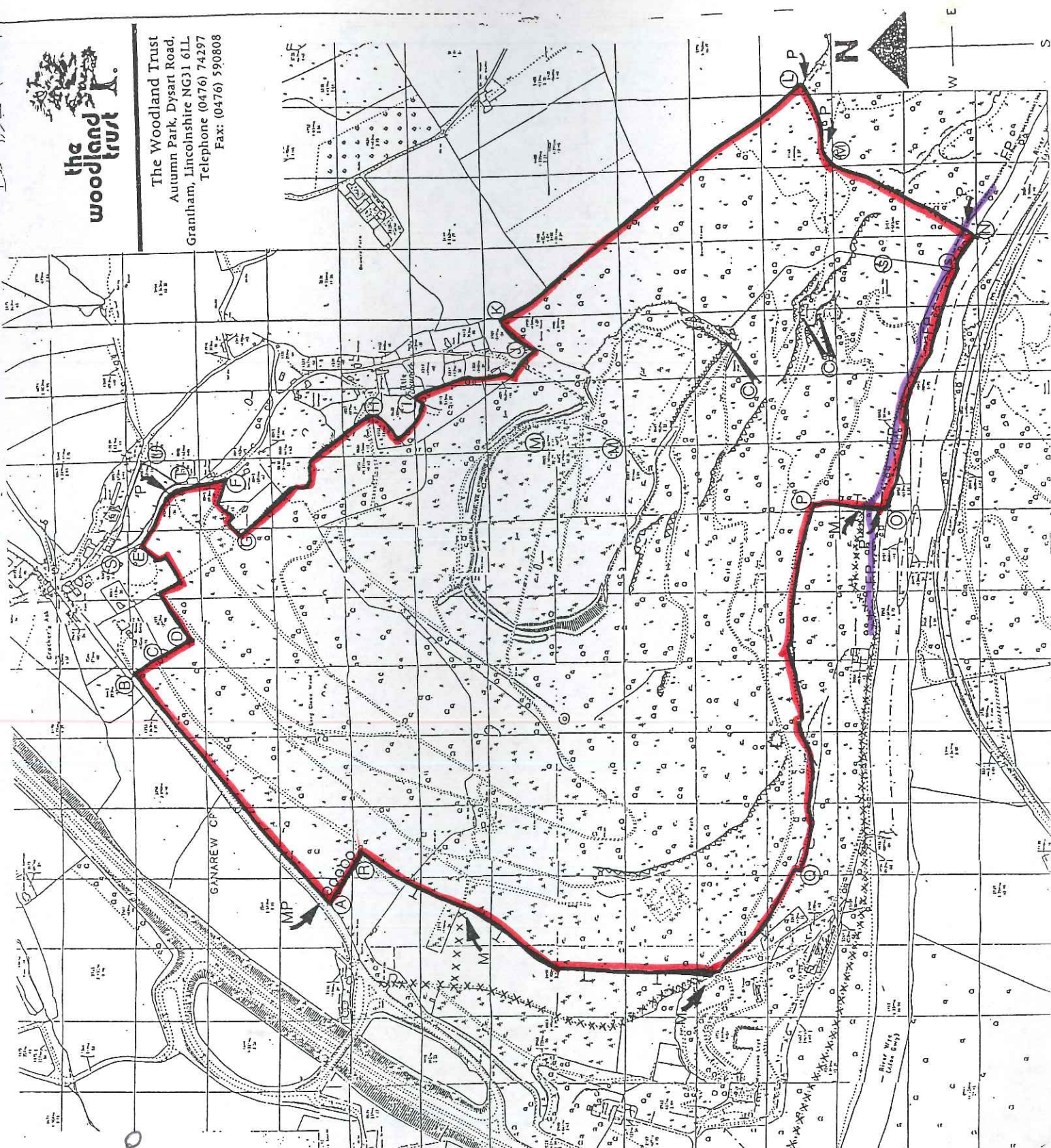

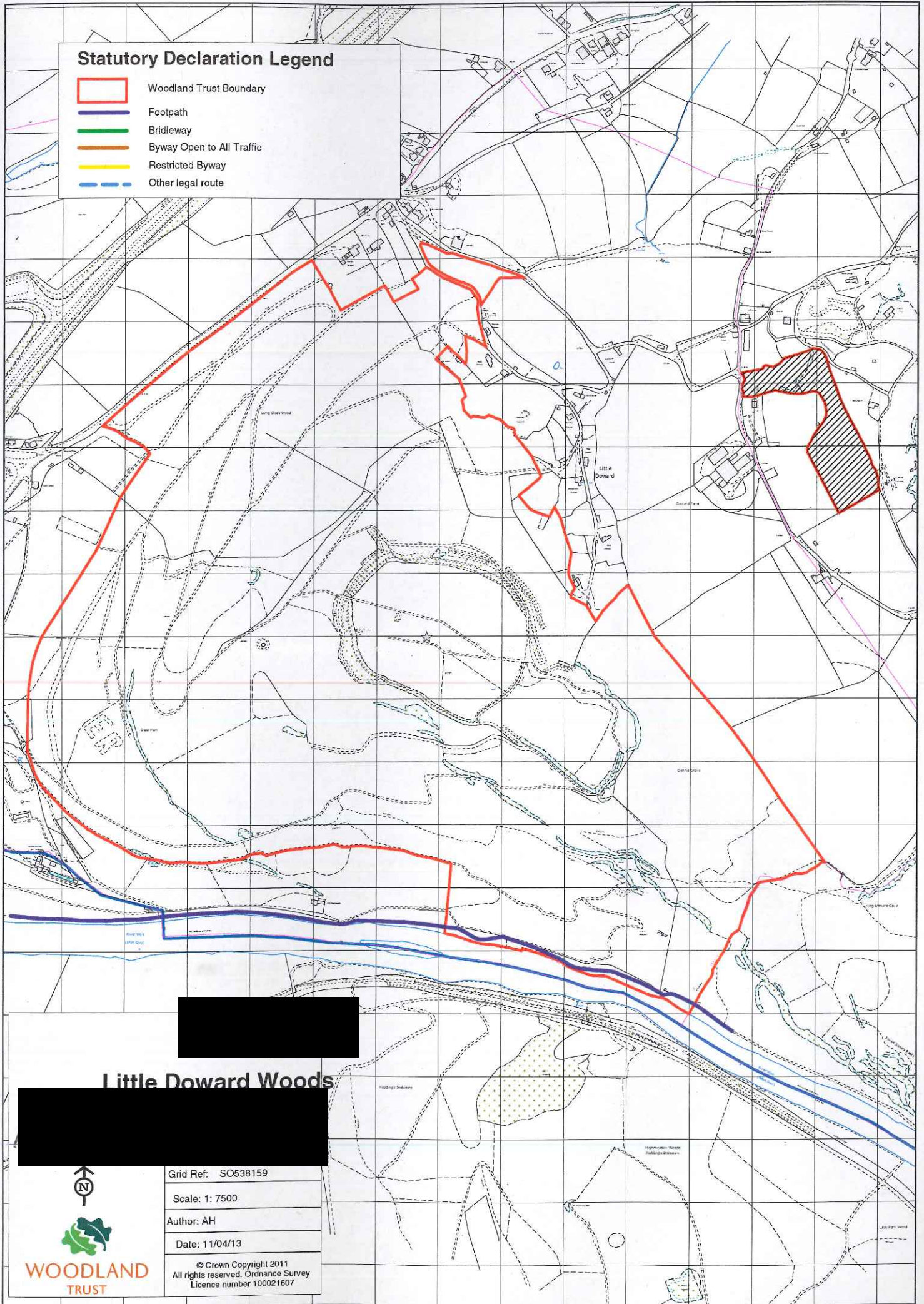
