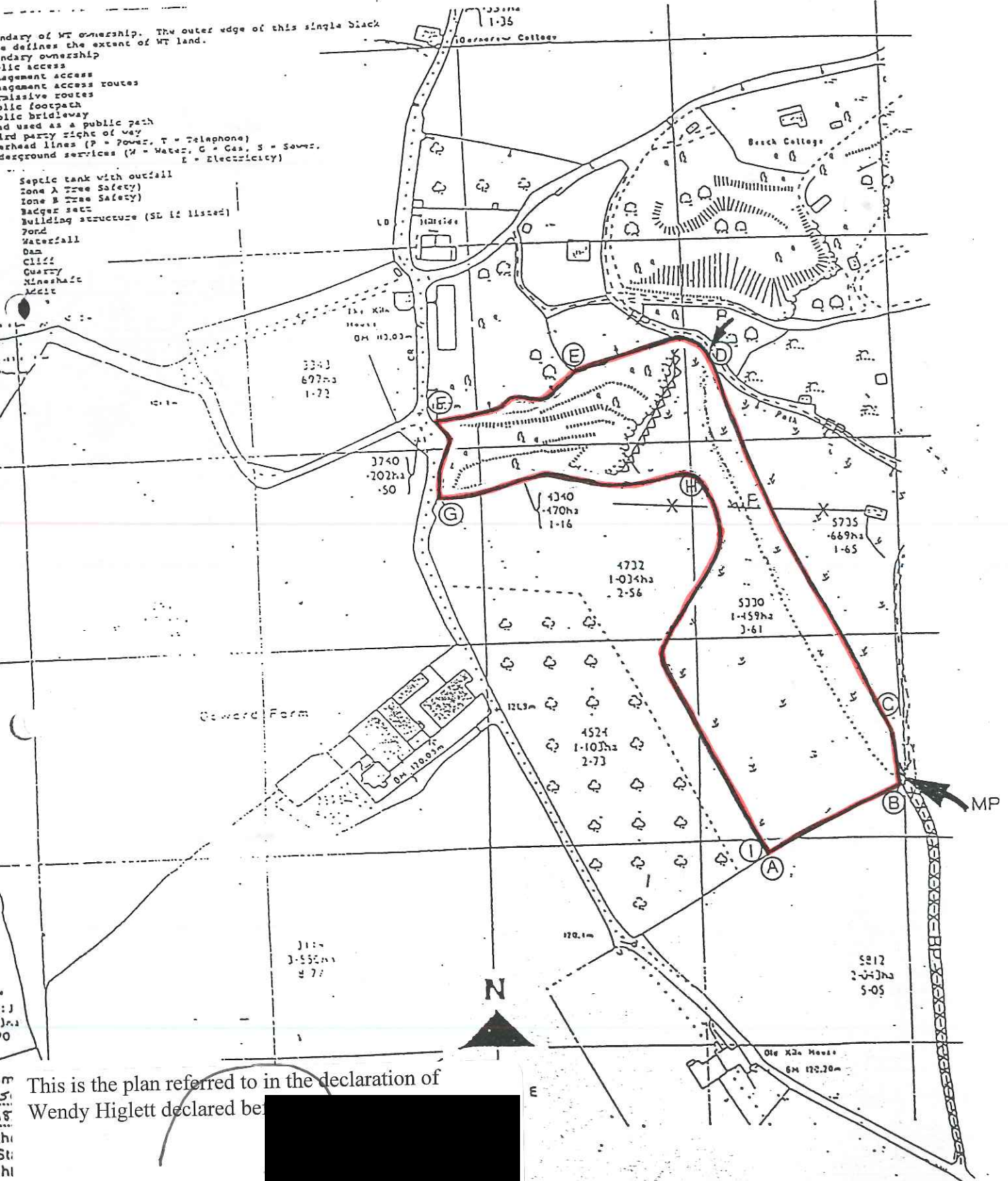

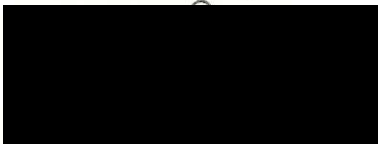

AND I MAKE this solemn declaration on the 24 day of September, 2003 conscientiously believing it to be true and by virtue of the Statutory Declarations Act 1835.

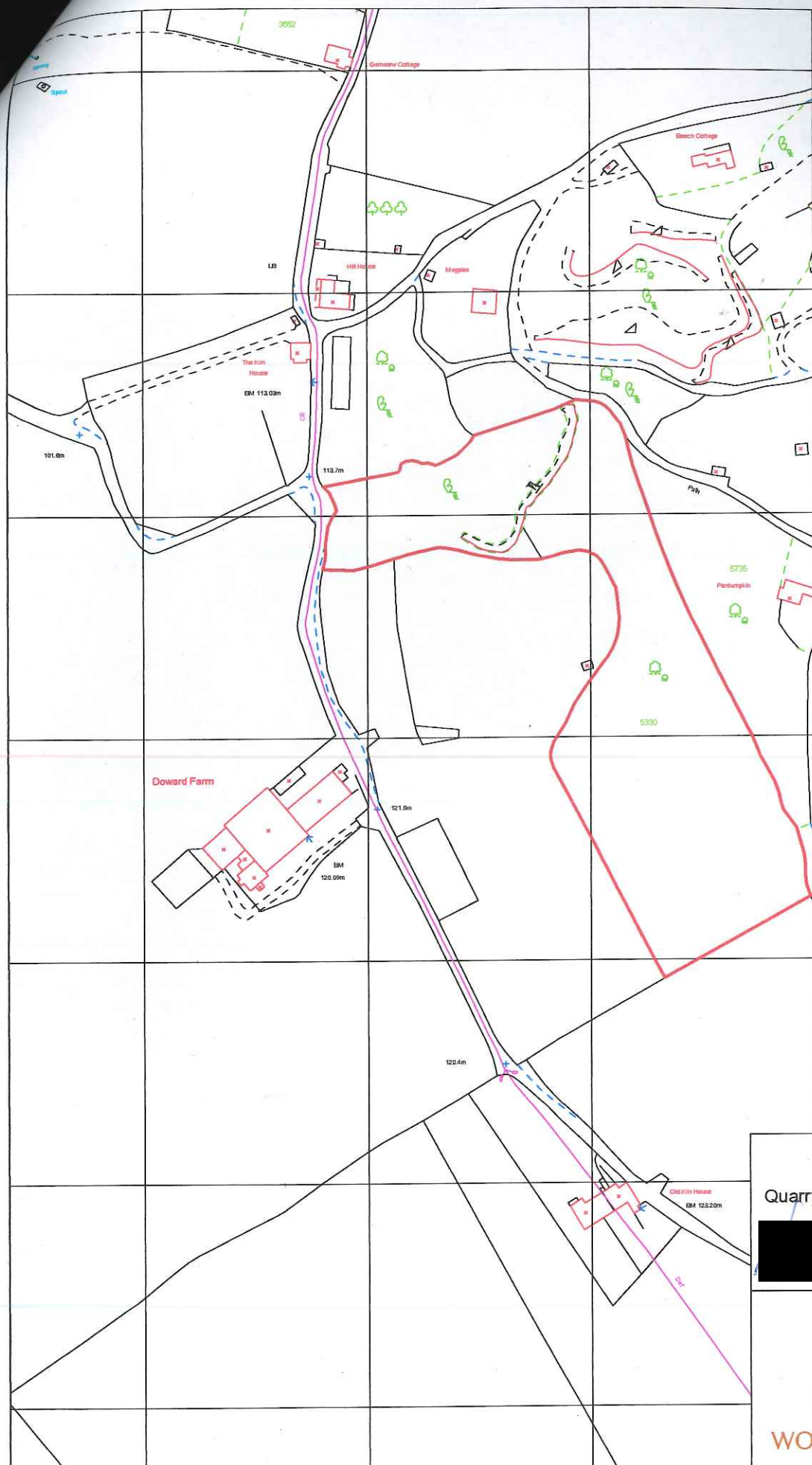

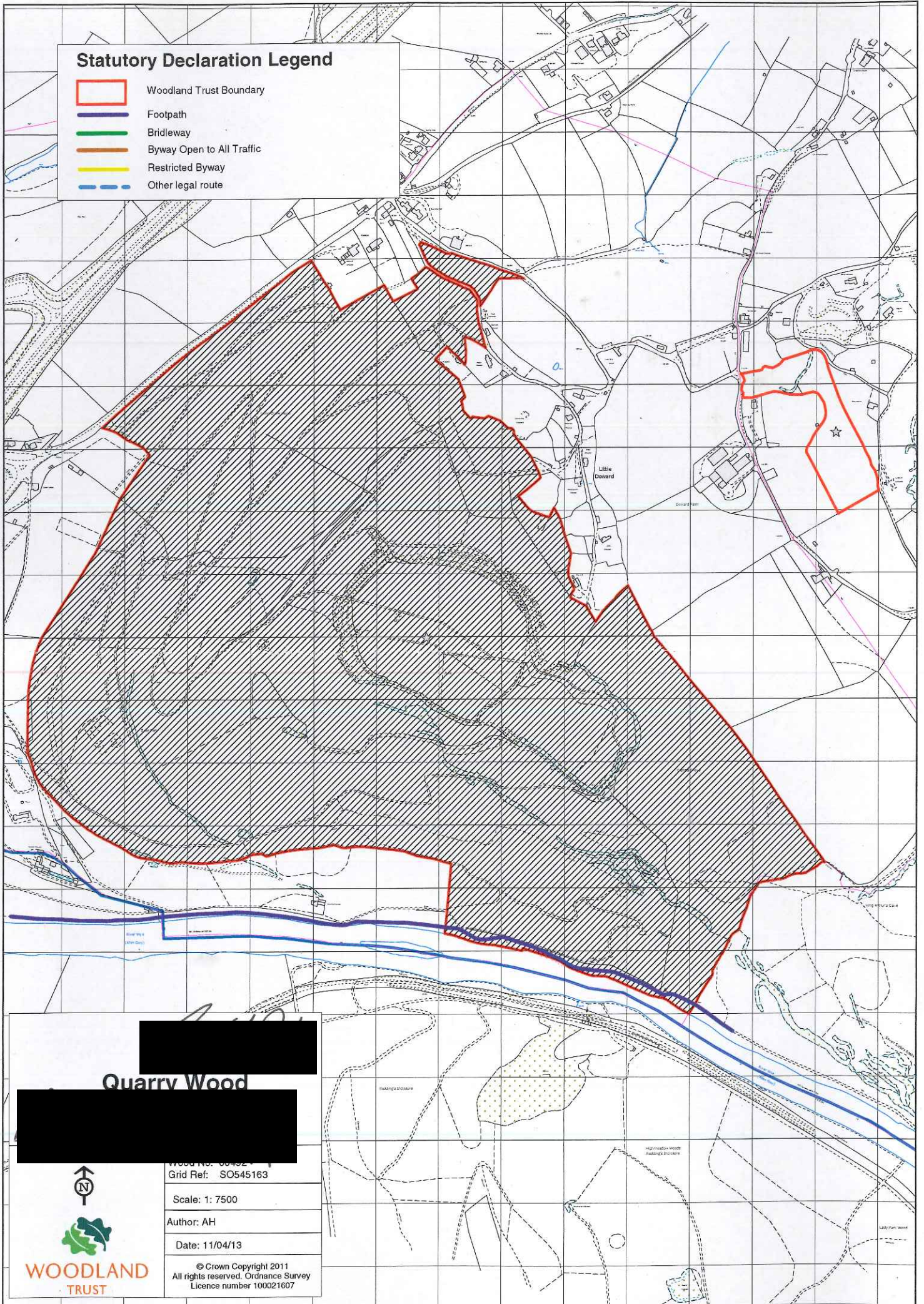

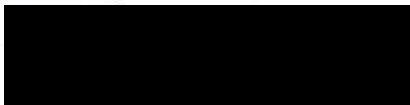
