Do you know about...

Development checks for two year olds

- Your child will be offered a development check by your health visitor when they're aged two / two and a half
- If your child goes to an early years childcare provider, they'll also carry out a progress check
- These checks form an integrated review for two year olds, which will give you a chance to talk about what your child can do and if there are any areas where they need a bit more support. Your health visitor and childcare provider, with your permission, will share their checks with each other and you can keep a record of this in your child's red book
