Excel Spreadsheet

Selecting a question - Screen 1

1. The tabs to the bottom of the excel spreadsheet represent each of the 38 questions
2. In order to see more questions, click on the arrows to the left of the tabs

Reading a response – Screen 2 & 3

Most of the responses will be able to be read via looking at the cell, however some responses are bigger than the cell. When this is the case do the following as shown in Screen 2 and 3

1. Single click the cell you wish to see the information for as shown on Screenshot 2
2. Click on the downward pointing arrow in the top right hand corner as shown on Screenshot 2
3. The comment will be displayed as shown in Screenshot 3

The majority of people who I went to school with, left Herefordshire at 18/19 to go to University and many have never come back (I can count on one hand those who have including myself). When I completed my degree, I applied for teaching posts in the County but due to the lack of them at that time, I sought and gained employment in the South East and was came back due to ill health (thankfully recovered from). We also need to increase the education level of those who remain in the County after leaving school and provide employment opportunities in order for them to learn whilst they earn but to a degree standard as well. We need to encourage a mix of employment areas rather than depending on one or two industry sectors. Working from home should be promoted and supported to reduce the traffic and congestion on roads but needs good infrastructure for this - especially the rural areas! However, we do also need to extend the opportunities for leisure time. We need a wide range of high class, accessible sports and leisure facilities for the whole community - high level income earners are well catered for, low - yes with free memberships at local leisure centres, but often it is middle income earners who are just above the low income brackets who could benefit with support and facilities too.
