


**WRITTEN STATEMENT OF A NON-KEY DECISION

Purpose:	To make the Staunton-on-Wye and District Group neighbourhood development plan as part of the statutory development plan for Herefordshire and approve consequential changes to the countywide policies map.
Decision:	<p>THAT:</p> <p>(a) the Staunton-on-Wye and District Group neighbourhood development plan is made as part of the statutory development plan for Herefordshire; and</p> <p>(b) the required consequential changes be made to the countywide policies map.</p>
Reasons for the Decision:	To fulfil the legal duty to make/adopt the Staunton-on-Wye and District Group neighbourhood development plan and update the countywide policies map as part of the statutory development plan for Herefordshire. Council delegated authority for the making of neighbourhood development plans, and consequential amendments to the countywide policies map, to the cabinet member infrastructure.
Options Considered:	There are no alternative options to making the Staunton-on-Wye and District Group neighbourhood development plan, following the legal requirements of a positive referendum result, on 14 April 2016, and compliance with European obligations and Human Rights conventions, as referred to in this report.
